



The Alliance Health Education Initiative (AHEI):

- Founded by the American Medical Association Alliance in 2012 as a 501(c)(3) organization
- Created to be an independent, non-profit, collaborative organization which addresses health education needs
- Awards health education grants to local, state and national levels of the Alliance as well as other health-oriented civic and charitable community groups
- Provides and accepts funding so that AHEI and other organizations can partner to implement health education programming
- Awarded 30 grants to alliances and health education organizations across the country since 2015
- Provided funding to projects addressing opioid misuse, mental health, children's health, care for the underserved, nutrition, wellness, physician burnout and many other health education endeavors
- Composed of a Board of Trustees, most of whom are AMA Alliance members
- Served currently by four past AMA Alliance Presidents functioning as either Trustees or Advisors
